

Please refer to your map inside the "Alton Towers New for 92" leaflet.

The stage has been built on the lake with the viewing area for concert licket holders being the CONCERT ARENA, the grassy area marked 'LAKESDE COFFEE SHOP'. On the day of the concert this arean will be cleared of the features marked. In addition there will be no splash cats and no rawing on the main lake. For the ease of a smooth running concert there may be further operational changes to the normal attractions of Alton Towers. These will be well signposted on the day and we ask you to co-operate with the Alton Towers staff in this regard.

At 3.30pm the staff will begin clearing everyone from the rides. Non James ticket holders will be escorted from the park, concert ticket holders will be filtered through to the concert arena.

At 4.45pm the front gates will open to concert-only ticket holders. Also at 4.45pm rides will re-open in Katanga Canyon, Gloomy Wood and Thunder Valley. These will remain open for approximately 45 minutes. At 5.30pm the bars in the marquees on the concert arena will open serving beers and wines. Soft drinks and food are available all day from the restaurants and klosks around the grounds.

The concert itself begins at 6pm and will end at 10.30pm. There are two exit routes to the car parks after the show. One through the main entrance through which you arrived and the other through Katanga Canyon by the 3D Cinema. Please listen to stewards instructions on exit.

Obviously with everyone leaving at once the roads out of Alton Towers will become heavily congested. Please be patient and co-operate with the exit stewards.



Transport

There is no public transport that will be in operation at the end of the concert. You are therefore advised to book coach travel to and from Alton Towers. WAY AHEAD ROCKTRIPS are running coaches from over sixty towns, listed opposite You can book a seat by ringing 0602 483456.

Trains

The nearest main line stations to Alton Towers are Stoke. Derby and Stafford. There will be no trains running from these stations until Sunday morning. Details of train travel are available from British Rail Travel Enquiries on 071 387 7070

Transfer to Stoke Station

There will be a very limited bus transfer service to Stoke station, leaving after the concert from the coach park. Please pay the driver on entry. At Stoke you will be dropped at the train station, from where you are on your own...

Nearest Petrol

The nearest 24 hour petrol stations to Alton Towers are situated in Littoyeter and Ashbourne (approximately 8 miles from Alton Towers). There are also stations in Meir and Hanley and services on the M6 and M1.

Leaving Alton Towers

As you will all be leaving the concert at the same time there will inevitably be queues and delays on the roads around Alton Towers. Please be patient and follow the signposted routes. Traffic will ease as you get further away from Alton Towers and approach the major roads.



Accommodation

There is no accommodation within the grounds of Alton Towers.

There are local campsites, B and B's, Guest Houses and Hotels. Comprehensive details of all these are contained in the Alton Towers "Where To Stay Guide", available by dialling 0538 702200.

Camping

The nearest campsite is the STAR CARAVAN and CAMPING PARK. This has full washing and tollet facilities, situated ⅓ of a mile from Alton Towers. Prices are £4.50 per tent (2 person), but you must book in advance. Telephone 0538 702256 / 308530 / 702219.

Information

First Aid

First Aid is available from the fully trained medical staff in the Alton Towers Medical Centre. The Medical Centre is situated near the entrance, adjacent to Bagshaws Family Restaurant on Towers Street. This will be open throughout the day until the park is clear at the end of the concert.

Toilets

In addition to the toilets marked on the map, you will find toilets situated to the right of the stage. The other toilets near the concert arena are on Towers Street, next to Bagshaws Family Restaurant.

Money

There is a bank situated at the top of Towers Street, near the entrance. The bank staff will be pleased to cash a cheque, supported by a valid bankers card.

Food and Drink

There are numerous stalls serving food and drink all day, situated around the ground, as marked on the map. When the concert arena opens you will find additional stalls selling food and drink. Alcohol can be purchased from the marquees on the concert arena from 5.30pm.

Admission to the Rides

There are two tickets in operation; an Alton Towers James Day Ticket and a James Concert Ticket. These are priced at £7.50 and £17.50 respectively. Your concert ticket does not entitle you to admission to Alton Towers until 4.45pm. At this time a limited number of rides will be open for 45 minutes. However, if you wish to purchase a ticket to ania admission to Alton Towers during

nowever, if you wish to purchase a toket to gain admission to Atton Howers during the day you may do so by sending £7.50 per person plus 75p booking fee to S.J.M. Ltd., P.O. Box 275, Warrington, Cheshire. This offer will close on Friday 26th June. You may also pay in to Alton Towers on the day from 9am, priced £8.50 adults, £7.00 children (4-13 yrs.).

In order to attend the concert you will need a concert ticket, priced £17.50.

Admission to the Park

Visitors are admitted subject to the condition that if required, they will submit themselves to be searched to prevent offensive weapons or dangerous articles from being taken into the park. Intoxicating liquor must not be taken into the park. Absolutely no glassware will be admitted for the safety of all.

These rules are made for the benefit of all our visitors and will be strictly enforced.

Litter

Please take all litter home or place it in one of the many bins around the grounds.

Lost Persons

Should you be separated from anyone on the day, the lost persons meeting point is the Medical Centre on Towers Street.
